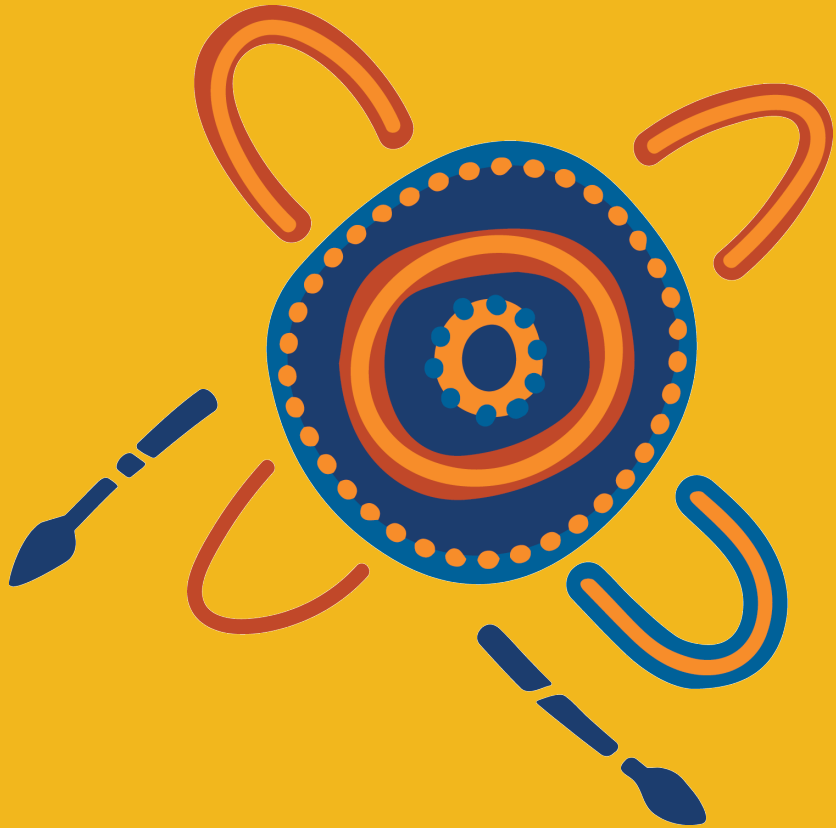




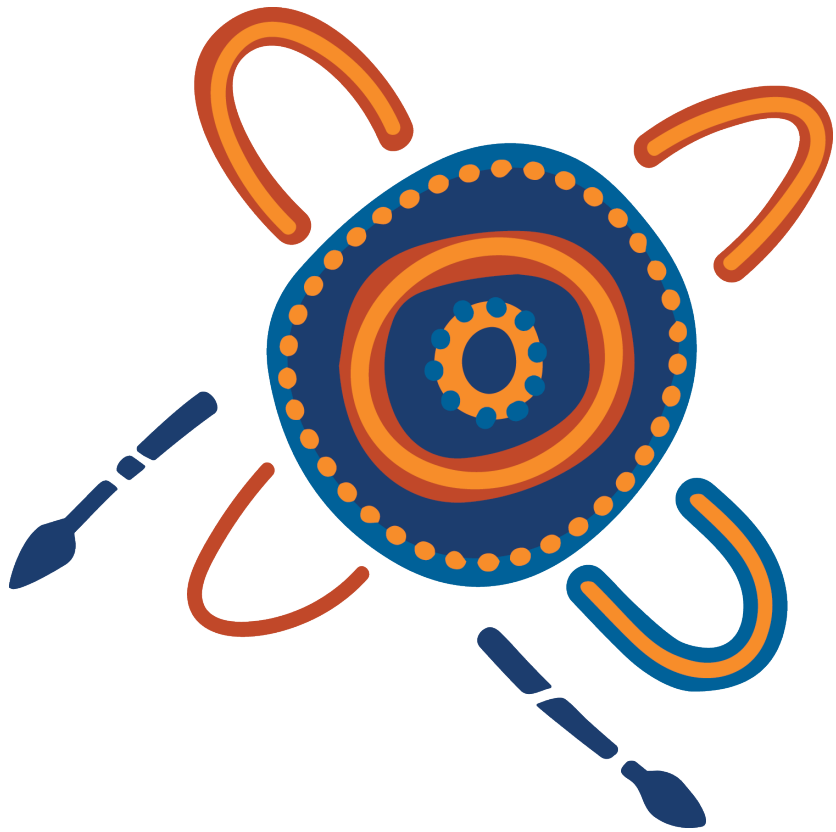

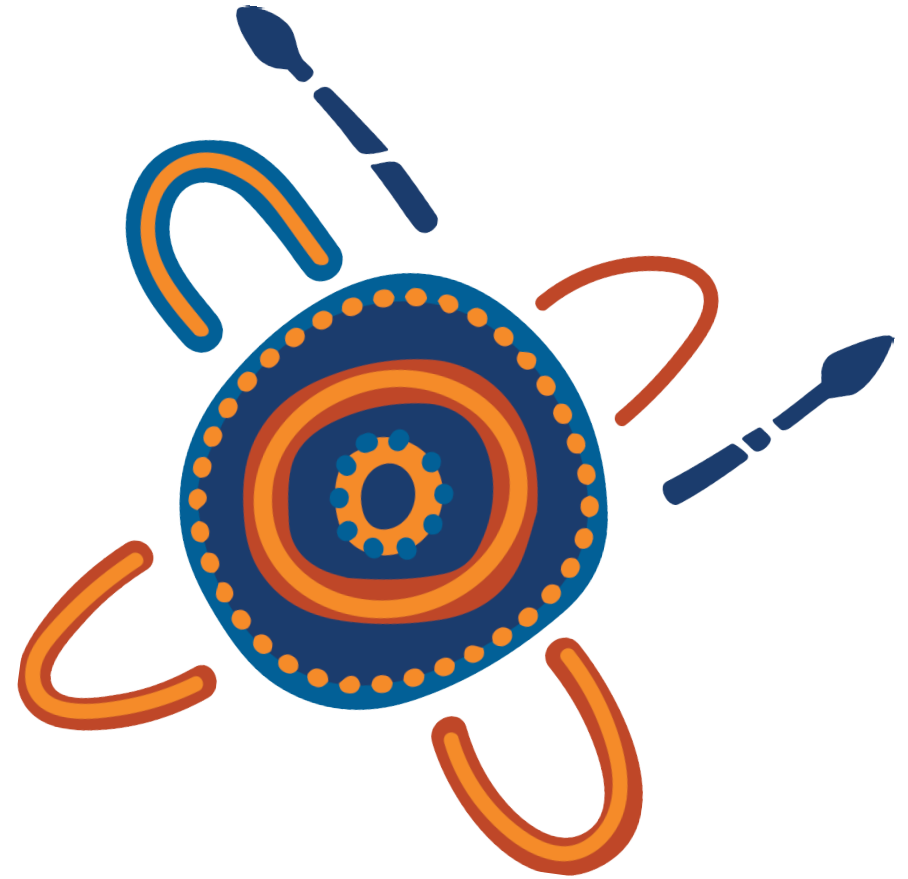

About the LGBTQA conversion practices ban



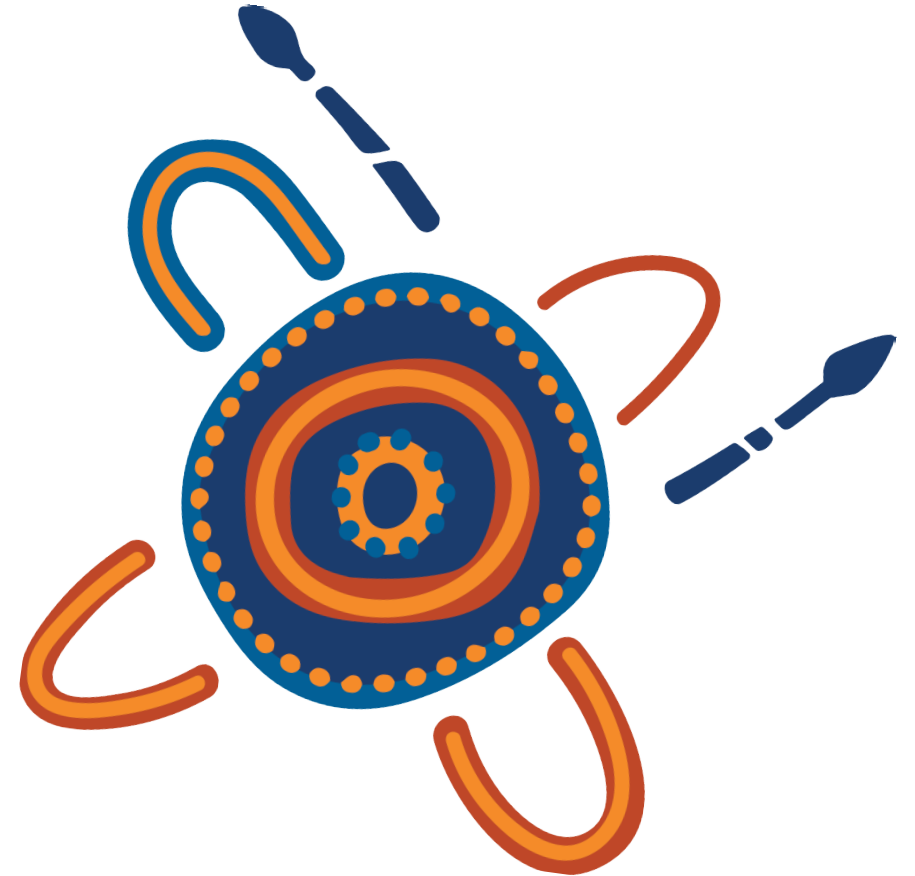
LGBTQA conversion practices are harmful practices which seek to change or suppress an individual's sexual orientation or gender identity. They are sometimes referred to as 'gay conversion' practices or 'conversion therapy'. Evidence shows that conversion practices are dangerous and damaging.

The conversion practices ban came into force in NSW on 4 April 2025.

You can report conversion practices to Anti-Discrimination NSW, which can help resolve complaints through conciliation. We have Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander staff members available to help.

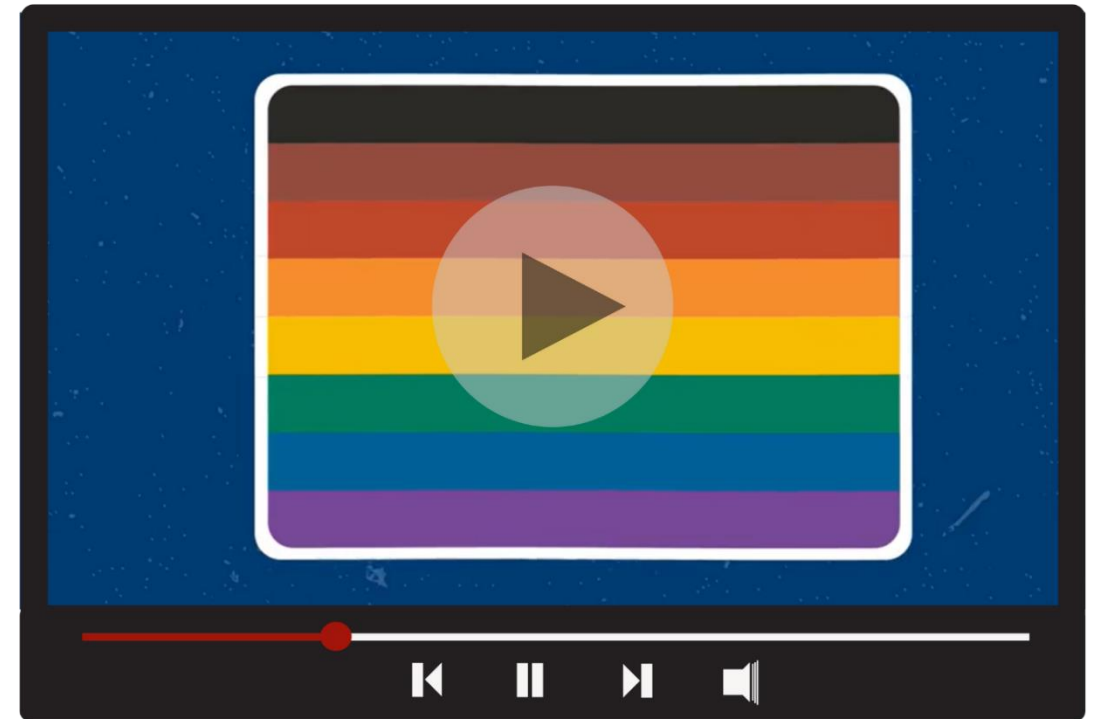

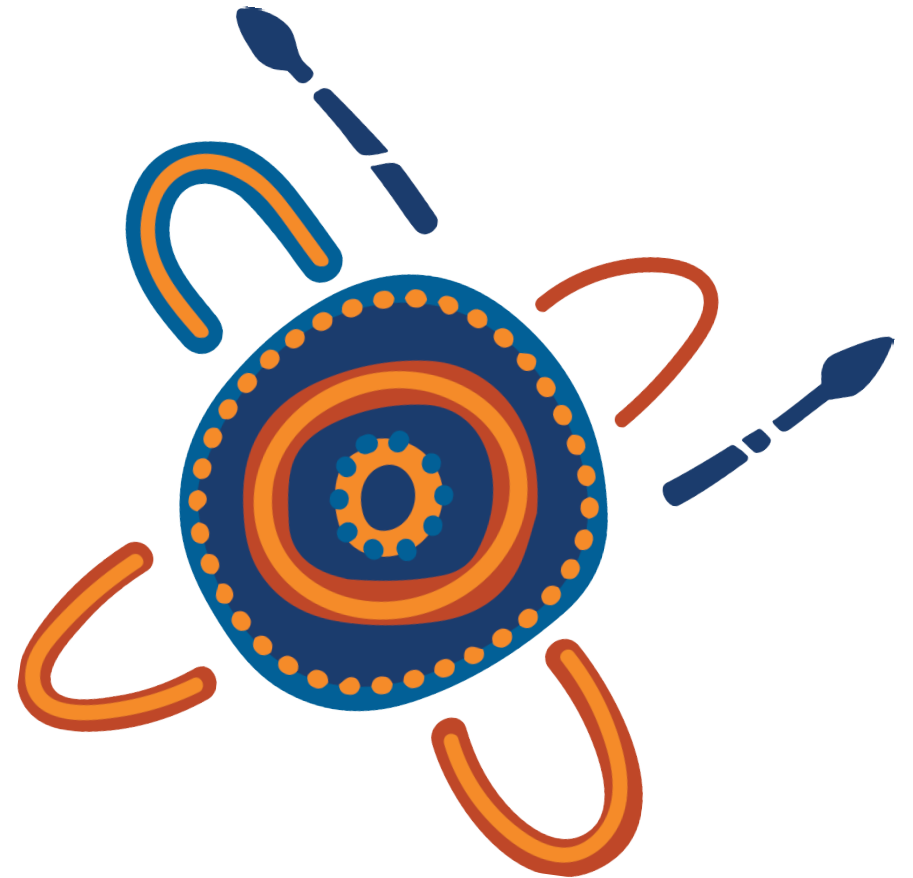
