




ADNSW Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Service

- We provide a confidential enquiry service.
- We investigate and conciliate discrimination complaints.
- We engage with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander organisations.
- We provide community information sessions about anti-discrimination laws and our services.

Anti-Discrimination NSW's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander team can help you address your problem. You may be able to deal with it locally, write a letter, organise information sessions or lodge a complaint. Our team can give you information so that you can decide what you want to do.
